The concept is simple—members can access their accounts at over 4200 participating locations nationwide. In order to perform transactions at a shared branching location, a member will need their credit union account number and photo identification.

The following are some of the services available at most shared branching locations:

- Deposit and withdrawals
- Transfers between accounts
- Loan payments
- Money orders/gift cards
- Extended hours of access



Shared branching is ideal for members who travel on business or pleasure, have children away at college, or relocate out of state—for any situation, it's easy and convenient.
